Monday	Group: Learn about our five senses. Sing song. "My Five Senses"	Sensory: (Centers) Match the smell game with scented cards.	Art: Explore disappearing colors with water colors and lemon juice.	Dramatic Play: (Centers) Play family with the dollhouse. Explore different possible family structures.	Large Muscle: Play Freeze Dance.	Manipulative: (Centers) Work with gears at the gear table.
Tuesday	Group: Talk about our sense of taste. Sing song, "The tasting song."	Science: (Centers) Explore taste testing with a variety of different tastes such as sweet, sour and bitter.	Math: Graph the results of our taste test for display in the classroom.	Art: (Centers) Make my favorite tastes collages.	Blocks: (Centers) Use blocks along with cars to build roads and bridges.	Large Motor: Group game, "The Shapes are on the Floor."
Wednesday	Group: Continue senses by learning about hearing! Sing, "The sound Song."	Sensory: (Centers) Use beans in the sand table, paying particular attention to the sounds they make in different containers.	Music: (Centers) Let children play creatively with musical instruments.	Language: (Centers) Let children explore making recordings of their own voice with a tape recorder.	Large Muscle: Play group game, Musical Chairs!	Science: (Centers) try to guess objects hidden in containers by the sound they make when shook.
Thursday	Group: Continue senses by learning about eyes and the sense of sight.	Language: (Centers) Enjoy time with various picture books in the book area.	Art: (Centers) Create open ended paintings with water colors!	Dramatic Play: (Centers) Role play Photographers. Use provided camera props and backgrounds.	Manipulative: Solve a maze with Learning fun sheet #11	Group game: Play silent Simon says encouraging children to watch carefully in order to follow along.
Friday	Group: Wrap up senses with the sense of touch! Use the Hands teaching card and practice corresponding rhyme.	Art: Finger painting! Enjoy your sense of touch by painting with your fingers!	Sensory: (Centers) Play with the Touch and feel box. Attempt to guess what you are feeling inside without peaking!	Science: (Centers) Explore Clean Mud in the water table	Blocks: (Centers) Build freely with small blocks.	Group: Play game, Duck Duck Goose as a group!
